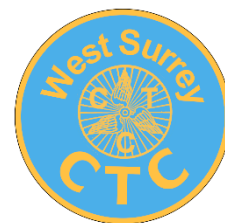

Group Riding Guidelines:

West Surrey CTC's riding principle is: **No-one left behind – bring everyone home safely**

Group riding is a wonderfully sociable way to cycle, and provides support when out riding; there will always be someone there to help you mend a puncture or help deal with a malfunction. However, group riding requires even greater discipline and awareness than solo cycling and the club's *Group Riding Guidelines* set out in detail the responsibilities of all riders, and is essential reading if you'd like to ride with us.

Changes to Published Rides: Late or last-minute changes to rides (e.g. as a result of adverse weather conditions) are advised in the **Latest News section of the website** (in the middle of the *Welcome / Home* page). Changes may also be advised by way of a **Google Groups e-mail**. If you want to receive these e-mail notifications, please go to the *Welcome* page on our website, look for *Quick Links* on the right-hand side, and click on *Sign up for announcements etc* (the 5th item down). Then specify which group(s) you'd like to receive announcements about.

Many groups are now using '**WhatsApp**' to communicate to others in a group. This is a mobile phone application and works just like normal SMS text messages. To find out more and join your WhatsApp group speak with your ride leader.
