Financial Report September 2019

This year the Club has made a deficit of £824. This has arisen as result of the Club running two First Aid courses at a net cost of £1365 and also a Ride Leaders day (£439). All these costs were carried by the Club, partially using the reserves bought forward from previous years. We have also purchased walkie-talkies for £25 for the Grade 3 ride leaders. First aid equipment has cost £100.

Financial performance for the last 8 years can be summarised as follows:

We continue to receive the majority of our income from the Tour of the Hills and the Elstead Audaxes.

In 2019 the surplus generated by the Tour of the Hills ride amounted to £1058 (2018 £965) and Elstead £95 (2018 £147). Increased Audax registration costs reduced the net income for the Elstead event.

This year we have a stock figure of £149 which is the net figure less subsidy of items that remain available for sale.
